## BROKEN ARROW STOPS WEBSTER FOR 20 – 13 WIN

BROKEN ARROW, November 5 – The clock ran out on Tulsa Webster here Friday night and enabled Broken Arrow to make off with a 20 – 13 victory.

The Warriors, who fought from a 13 – 0 deficit to gain a tie, drove 98 yards in the waning minutes and had a first down on the Broken Arrow one when time ran out.

Broken Arrow scored in the first period on a 61-yard drive the first time it had possession. **Tony Banfield** going five yards around end for the touchdown.

After Webster drove to the Broken Arrow 10 and fumbled, Broken Arrow then drove 90 yards for the second touchdown with **Bill Lemon** passing to **Ted Eakes** for nine yards and the score. **Chuck Coleman** plunged for the extra point and a 13 – 0 lead.

Webster then dominated play the remainder of the second quarter to drive 70 yards for its initial touchdown. **Charles Scott** ran over from five yards out and **Don Jenkins** plunged over for the seventh point for the 13 – 7 halftime reading.

Webster struck again at the start of the third quarter by recovering a fumble on the first play from scrimmage at the Broken Arrow 32-yard line. **Scott** circled right end for 13 yards and after a loss on the next play he passed to **Danny Burton** for 23 yards and the touchdown. The attempted plunge for extra point was no good to leave the issue deadlocked, 13 – 13.

Broken Arrow sewed up the victory in the fourth period by driving 60 yards with **Eakes** going over from the one. **Coleman** ran over the point.

Webster went into its spread formation and failed to gain and with four minutes to play took over again at its own 2-yard line and drove to the **Broken Arrow** one before the gun stopped the charge.

The key play in the drive was a 36-yard run by **Scott**.

### Broken Arrow Ledger

Fans last Friday night – besides freezing to death – saw one of the most thrilling (other than Nowata) games of the season – a game which saw no spectators leave until the game was over.

The top quarter saw the Tigers take control of the ball on their own 40. **Chuck Coleman**, on one of the initial plays of the game, plunged through the Tulsa line to pick up a first down on the Tulsa 49. The next play **Ted Eakes** moved the ball to the Tulsa 45 followed by a line plunge by **Tony Banfield** for another eight yard gain to the Tulsa 37. **Eakes** picked up another first down for his squad on the Tulsa 26, followed by a **Banfield** crash through the line to the Tulsa 10. **Banfield** then carried the ball over for the Tigers first marker, but the extra point was no good. The score – 6 to 0, Tigers.

Tulsa Webster returned the kickoff to their own 32. The next play saw the ball carrier plunge down to the 45 and then hurled the ball to the Tiger 45. The next two plays saw Tulsa move quickly to the Tiger 29 and then to the Tiger eight yard line. The quarter ended.

With a first down and goal Tulsa fumbled and Broken Arrow recovered on its own ten yard line. **Eakes** then moved the ball to the Tiger 16 but Tulsa held the Tigers forcing a punt. Tulsa fumbled the punt and **Carl Gragg** recovered for Broken Arrow on the Tiger 40. **Coleman** pushed the ball up for a six yard gain. **Banfield** picked up a first down and **Eakes** then moved the ball down to the Webster 22. **Banfield** plunged through the Tulsa line again to place the ball on the Tulsa 9 and a pass from **Bill Lemon** to **Eakes** on the next play netted another six points for the Tigers. **Coleman** made the extra point and the score climbed to 13 – 0, Tigers.

Tulsa racked up its first score of the game in the second quarter. Tulsa took the Tiger kick off on its own 49 and a pass from **Allen Hendrickson** to **Butch Lucas** was good for 25 yards and moved the ball to the Tiger 27. Tulsa's **Don Scott** moved the ball to the Tiger 11 on a line crasher and then he took the ball over the line for a touchdown. **Don Jenkins** made the extra point. The score 13 – 7, Tigers.

Early in the third quarter **Eakes** fumbled on the Tiger 25 and Tulsa recovered. A Pass from **Scott** to **Danny Burton** was good for a second marker for the Warriors, but they missed the extra point and the game was knotted at 13. This probably was the Tiger squad's worst few minutes of the season – even though it wasn't a conference tilt.

The Tigers took the lead again at 20 – 13 moving 60 yards with **Eakes** scoring the TD and **Coleman** running for the extra point.

The Warriors lived up to their name moving the ball 96 yards from their own 2-yard line before running out of time. Ending the game with the Tigers in front 20 – 13. Webster was the last team to defeat the Tigers.
