HB 2417 (3)

Enns Allows concealed handguns to be carried into public or private elementary or secondary school, provided that the board of education of a public school district has adopted a policy allowing concealed handguns. Last Action: 2-6-12 H Referred to House Committee on House Public Safety

HB 2422 (3)

Denney Adds to the data to be added to Oklahoma School Testing Program; data will come from any AP course taught at high schools, tech centers, or regional sites of OSSM; includes cooperative college alliance credit courses; EMERGENCY. HB 2511 (3)

SB 1056 (3)

Simpson Adds pilot program establishment in technology center school districts. SB 1086 (3)

Coates Allows students with an ACT score that falls within the 41 to 100 percentile levels to be deemed as satisfactorily demonstrated mastery of state academic content standards; determines them to be eligible for graduation; EMERGENCY. SB 1101 (3)

SB 1103 (3)

SB 1228 (3)
