SERVICE LEARNING

- o **Community Service** – Broken Arrow students often seek opportunities to give back to the community, and the Community Service Program seeks to connect Partners with students, for the purpose of accomplishing acts of community service.
- o **Internships** – Partners in Education will have the opportunity to be matched with students seeking internships that allow them to explore different careers and the responsibilities that come with those careers. This program is curriculum based, and students will receive academic credit for the period of time they participate.
- o **Apprenticeships** – Partners who participate in the Apprenticeship Program will be matched with students who have an intense interest in a particular field. This program is curriculum based, and students will receive academic credit for the period of time they participate.
