Broken Arrow High School prom for juniors and seniors will be held Saturday, April 27, from 8 p.m. – 11 p.m. at Stoney Creek Convention Center located at 200 W Albany Street in Broken Arrow. Academic eligibility will not be a requirement this year, although students must be meeting the code of conduct.

To enter this event, students must have their current student ID, have their prom ticket and follow the [school dance dress code](#).

Prom tickets are \$45 per person and can be purchased in the student union on April 17-19 for seniors only and April 22-25 for both juniors and seniors. **Tickets will not be sold at the door.**

Students who want to bring a guest from another school must complete the [guest form](#) and return to Mrs. Stecker by Friday, April 19. Mrs. Stecker's office is located in the student union.
