

Parent Information for Graduation 2019

Broken Arrow High School's senior class will walk across the stage at the BOK Center to receive their diplomas on Wednesday, May 8, 2019.

For the past few years, the graduating class has exceeded the 1,000 mark making the move to a larger venue a necessity. With a seating capacity of almost 16,000, the BOK Center provides seating for family and friends of seniors who wish to attend the ceremony. Tickets will not be utilized for entry, and there is no limit placed on the number of guests each student may invite. **Seating will be available on a first come, first served basis, and saving seats is prohibited.**

Doors will open at 5:30 for guests. **The Broken Arrow Expressway near downtown is closed, so patrons should be sure to allow plenty of time for arrival and parking.** The ceremony will begin at 7 p.m.

Families and friends of graduating seniors should also be aware that there will be a bag check at the door. To decrease the amount of time it takes to enter the facility and find seats, patrons may want to consider leaving bags and purses at home.

Broken Arrow High School's Project Graduation has given graduating seniors a way to celebrate their achievement with classmates in a supervised, fun and safe environment for more than 25 years. New for the Class of 2019, the all-night lock-in event will be held at Incredible Pizza following the commencement ceremony of May 8.

Doors at Incredible Pizza will open to graduates at 11 p.m. and will close at midnight. Students must be wearing the wristband they receive for the graduation ceremony, and they will **NOT** be allowed to leave early once they have been admitted. Students will be released at 4 a.m.

Pillows, blankets and backpacks are not permitted, but small purses and bags may be checked in. Students who are in attendance at Project Graduation will not be expected to attend school on Thursday, May 9.
