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## Dual College Credit

The deadline to apply for a dual college credit degree is January 31. Beginning in the summer after a student's sophomore year in high school, program participants will take part in a rigorous course of college study and, if successful, will earn a Liberal Arts Associate Degree from Tulsa Community College and a high school diploma from Broken Arrow High School simultaneously.

The program has enrollment criteria a student must meet in order to be eligible to participate. Students must have a minimum score of 510 on the PSAT/SAT reading and writing section and a 510 on the math section or a minimum score of 19 on both the reading and English and math sections of the ACT. Students must also be on track with their graduation credits.
