Recognizing the need for students to have some unscheduled time to spend with family or to pursue non-school related activities, the standard school week shall be recognized as Monday through Friday for formal classroom activities, unless exception is authorized by the Board of Education. All other school programs, and extra-curricular activities of the school system and/or activities of parent support groups involving students from a school activity group shall be limited to Monday through Saturday.

Further, school activities shall not be scheduled on Wednesday evening, after 6:00 p.m. School district employees will not conduct practices or hold meetings involving students, nor make available facilities for student use, practices, or meetings on Wednesday evenings or at any time on Sunday. Requests for consideration of special, one-time Wednesday evening or Sunday events shall be by the principal who is authorized to approve such special, one-time requests, as he/she deems appropriate. The Superintendent is authorized to make broader exceptions to this rule, as he/she deems appropriate, with notice to the Board of Education.
