POLICY 4420

UNAUTHORIZED VEHICLE SEARCH ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

As part of a comprehensive program to protect the health, safety and welfare of Broken Arrow students and personnel, unauthorized vehicles parked in the parking lots at District sites are subject to search and/or towing at the owner's expense according to this Policy.

1. The limited purpose of this Policy is to maintain order and discipline on District property.
2. The school principal or designee is authorized to detain and search and/or tow any vehicle not bearing a valid District parking permit.
3. Such search may be conducted without an individualized suspicion, consent, or warrant.
4. Persons entering District parking lots without a valid parking permit will be provided notice that their vehicle and its contents are subject to search and/or towing by the posting of a sign.
5. The superintendent or designee will establish a procedure for the identification, search, towing, and reporting of any searches conducted pursuant to this policy.
