

BROKEN ARROW LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Seniors should be on the lookout for scholarships and other money that can assist with funding their college plans. Local scholarship applications are now available for students to begin the application process, and these scholarships are only available to Broken Arrow High School seniors!

The local scholarships and applications are listed on the College and Career website or paper applications can be picked up in the College and Career office Main 124. Students may type on the applications online, then print and turn in to Mrs. Miler in BAHS Main 124 in the College and Career office.

When completing the scholarship applications, please consider the following helpful tips:

- Read and follow all instructions carefully.
- When typing the applications on the computer, make sure the spacing and font are neat. If you need to add spaces, lines, change the font, etc. please take the time to use your best judgment in typing them to look professional.
- Take note of where you must submit the application. Some applications will need to be mailed and others are returned to the College and Career office.
- For most of the scholarships the College and Career office will submit your transcript for you, but for the applications to be mailed, students will need to request a transcript (through Parchment) in advance.
- Please make note of deadlines. For applications returned to the College and Career Office the **deadline is March 25, 2024**. Those that are mailed may have an earlier or later deadline.
- Recipients will be announced at the BAHS Scholarship Awards Assembly in May.

These are local scholarships only. Students should also search and apply for other state and national scholarships. Students may want to consider looking at the websites listed on the BAHS College and Career page www.baschools.org/collegeandcareer as a resource.

BROKEN ARROW LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS - Spring 2024

The first section of scholarship applications is the student's responsibility to mail to the appropriate organization. The address and due dates are included on the application. Please request transcripts (through Parchment) as soon as possible for these applications.

- 1 Broken Arrow Soccer Club Scholarship** – BASC annually awards three \$500 undergraduate college tuition scholarships to current BASC players. The awards are open to both men and women and are paid directly to the recipient. Both are funded from the BASC general fund. Qualifications include: graduating high school senior, current player, coach or referee, must have registered and participated for a minimum of three (3) years (six seasons) in either the BASC recreational and/or competitive league. All applications must be submitted online by April 7, 2024 to be considered. www.basoccer.club/recreational/college-scholarships/
- 2 Broken Arrow Community Foundation Scholarship** - The Broken Arrow Community Foundation, Inc., will award the Charlene Sturgeon Memorial Scholarship and Warren B Hudson Scholarship of \$2,500.00 each to graduating Broken Arrow High School seniors. Applications must be postmarked no later than April 1, 2024.

Warren B Hudson Scholarship

The scholarships may be used to cover the costs while attending an institution of higher education, vocational-technical school, or other post-secondary education program.

The Charlene Sturgeon Memorial Scholarship is reserved **specifically** for students to attend post-secondary studies in vocational-technical-craftsman career fields.

- 3 **BAHS 1956 Senior Class Coach Joe Robinson Scholarship** - Will be awarded to a Broken Arrow High School graduating senior student. Applicants for the 1956 Senior Class Coach Joe Robinson Scholarship must meet the following criteria: Completed the last eight (8) years of his/her education in Broken Arrow Public Schools, have been an athlete and participated in one or more of the following sports: Football, Basketball, Track and Field program(s), maintained average or higher grades and demonstrated diligence in work and studies. Applications must be postmarked no later than April 1, 2024.
- 4 **Vinita J. (Shirley) Oliver Scholarship for the Fine Arts** – A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating Broken Arrow High School senior who desires to pursue studies in the Fine Arts (performing or visual arts). Applications must be postmarked no later than April 1, 2024.
- 5 **Charles C. Faranna Scholarship** - The Charles C. Faranna Scholarship fund awards several scholarships to deserving seniors who are planning on attending college. Filing deadline is April 1, 2024.

All scholarship applications can be found on the Scholarship List on the College and Career website. The following applications must be turned in to the College and Career Office, Main 124, by 3:00 p.m. March 25, 2024. DO NOT request transcripts for these applications. The College and Career Office will attach an official copy of your transcript once all applications are submitted.

- 6 **Broken Arrow Alumni Association “Tiger Scholar” Scholarship** –The Broken Arrow Alumni Association scholarship is awarded to graduating senior(s) who meets criteria and have attended Broken Arrow Public Schools from grades 1-12. The criteria also include: minimum 2.75 GPA and plans for enrollment in a College or University, Technical School, or Jr. College.
- 7 **Broken Arrow Civitan Club** - The Broken Arrow Civitan Club will award the annual scholarship of \$1000 to a senior boy or girl who desires to attend college with the idea of helping children or adults with special needs. The applicant's considered major should be in the field of special education or occupational/recreational therapy.
- 8 **Broken Arrow Education Association Deanna Rosser-Coatney Memorial Scholarship** - This scholarship will be awarded to a BAHS senior who has overcome an obstacle, great or small, in his/her life. You must be nominated by any BA Education Association member, achieve a 2.5 or higher GPA, and other criteria. All applications are accepted; however, preference will be given to those entering the education field.
- 9 **Broken Arrow High School Parent Teacher Student Association Scholarship** - Scholarship will be awarded to BAHS students who will attend college, technical or trade school full time. Applicants must be a member of the PTSA. (Membership forms may be found on the Broken Arrow High School PTSA Facebook page under the “shop now” tab and turned in at BAHS main office), be enrolled at BAHS for one year or more consecutively, have GPA of 3.0 or greater.
- 10 **Broken Arrow Historical Society Foundation The Gladys Tomlinson Memorial Scholarship** - The Broken Arrow Historical Society Foundation, Inc., is pleased to announce that scholarships of \$1000 are to be awarded to graduating high school seniors from schools located within the Broken Arrow, Oklahoma metropolitan area (The BA metropolitan area is the area within the city limits of Broken Arrow and/or the Broken Arrow School District boundary). Selection of recipients will be determined on the basis of scholarship, leadership, financial need, and community involvement.
- 11 **Broken Arrow Rotary Club** - The Broken Arrow Rotary Club will award several scholarships to graduating seniors from Broken Arrow High School. The scholarships may be utilized to cover the costs of tuition, books, fees and other expenses while attending an institution of higher education, vocational-technical training center, or other post-secondary training programs approved by the Broken Arrow Rotary Club. Criteria include 3.2 GPA, and a balance of community service, financial need and academic achievement.
- 12 **First National Bank and Trust Company of Broken Arrow** - First National Bank and Trust Company of Broken Arrow may award one \$8000 scholarship (\$1000 per semester) to a local graduating senior. Qualifications include 3.0 GPA, student or parents have a minimum of nine months banking relationship with FNB prior to graduation, and must plan to attend a college or university leading to a Bachelor's degree. - 13 Max E. Smith Leadership Scholarship** - The Max E. Smith Leadership scholarship will be presented to a graduating senior who most demonstrated the traits and exhibited the duties of a leader through his or her dedicated commitment and service to Broken Arrow High School and its student activity program. Criteria includes: active in clubs or organizations during attendance at BAHS; held office (either elected or appointed) during senior year, and minimum 3.0 GPA.
- 14 Mervin Bovaird Foundation** - The Mervin Bovaird Foundation will award one scholarship toward tuition at The University of Tulsa to a BAHS senior. The scholarship is for \$6000 per year for four years or eight (8) consecutive semesters.
- 15 Blood Drive Scholarship** - Applicants must have: donated blood at least 3 times while a student at BAHS, or worked at a BAHS blood drive for at least 16 hours, or worked at least 8 hours and donated blood at least 1 time.
- 16 Rick Wambold Memorial Scholarship** - The Rick Wambold Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a Broken Arrow High School Graduating Senior who has been affected by the suicide of a family member (parent, sibling, grandparent, aunt/uncle, first cousin). The Scholarship of \$500.00 may be utilized toward the cost of tuition and fees while attending an institution of higher education. Qualification includes a minimum GPA of 2.5 (based on 4.0 scale).
- 17 Video Production Scholarship** - The BAHS ArrowVision program is pleased to offer a \$1000.00 scholarship. This scholarship is designed to assist students in the video production, broadcasting program to help further their education. (This scholarship is in honor of Steve Cowen, Gordon Moeller and Terry Spreiter who laid the foundation for the BAHS video program.) Applicants must be a graduating senior of Broken Arrow High School with a 3.0 GPA or higher and must have been in the BAHS video production program for at least 2 years.
- 18 Scott Tully Scholarship** - The family of Scott Tully is pleased to offer two \$1000.00 scholarships in his memory. This scholarship is designed to support student athletes in furthering their education.
- 19 Betty Blackburn Memorial Educational Scholarship** - This \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who plans on entering the field of education. You must have a GPA of 3.0 to qualify. This application must be **turned in to the College and Career Office, Main 124 March 8, 2024.**
- 20 Northeastern State University** – One-time \$500 tuition waiver to be used at Northeastern State University for the 2024-2025 school year.
