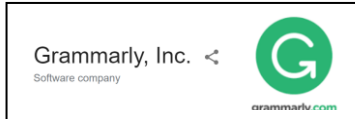


BAHS AP Exams

1. **Disable Grammarly:** NO AP exams will work properly with Grammarly on your computer. Go to settings, then “More Tools”, then “Extensions”. You’ll see the Grammarly extension. **Remove it or just disable it.**



2. **AP Exam day ticket:** You will receive a separate e-ticket for each exam you are taking through your email and in your student account on My AP: <https://myap.collegeboard.org/login>. This will arrive 2 days before each exam.
3. **AP Exam demo:** Go to cb.org/apdemo to access an AP 2020 Exam Demo. It will allow you to **practice the different ways to submit your responses**. If you **can't** connect to this demo from your planned testing device, you'll not be able to access the real exam on test day.
4. **AP Exam day checklist:** Complete this checklist before each exam. cb.org/apchecklist
5. **AP Exam times:** We are in the **CENTRAL TIME** zone! Log in using your e-ticket **30 minutes before** each exam start time. (There are security questions to answer.)
