CPR Training

According to State Law, known as the "Dustin Rhodes and Lindsay Steed CPR Training Act", beginning with the 2015-2016 school year, all students enrolled in grades nine through twelve in the public schools of this state shall receive instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and awareness of the purpose of an automated external defibrillator, at least once between ninth grade and graduation from high school. Normally this is done in ninth grade, however, due to school closure due to COVID, the class of 2023 was unable to complete this requirement. In order to fulfill this requirement, we are going to provide training to all 10th graders on **April 21st, 28th**, **and May 5th** through advisory classes. **May 19th** will be a make-up day.
