

Parent Teacher Conferences

Parent/Teacher conferences will be on Tuesday, 10/13 and Thursday, 10/22 from 3:00-6:30 p.m. at BAHS. If you'd like to schedule a virtual or in-person conference at BAHS with one or more of your child's teachers, please communicate with your child's grade-level Counseling Secretary to schedule the virtual or in-person appointment.

If requesting a virtual conference, teachers will email you a Zoom meeting link prior to scheduled meeting time. If scheduling an in-person conference, a mask mandate is still in effect for all guests and temperature checks will be taken in the grade-level offices (A, B, and D) and Main Office.

PSAT Exam

All sophomores and juniors taking the PSAT/NMSQT will report to school as normal, eat breakfast, as needed, and then report to the designated testing location. Students who are testing should bring their own calculator. Buses will run on normal schedule for both morning and afternoon routes

After the test is complete, at approximately 12:00-12:30, students will sign out of their testing location and can report to lunch and then the field house for the remainder of the school day, or they may ride home with a parent/guardian. Lunch WILL be provided at approximately 12:30-1:15.

Parents are NOT required to call or email to check students out of school after the test is complete, because the end of the testing session is considered the end of the instructional day on 10/14. Please communicate ahead of time your plans for your child to either stay on campus for the remainder of the day in the field house and ride the bus home OR receive parent/guardian-provided transportation home after the test is complete.

Students not testing will have a distance learning day and will need to log-in from home and complete lessons and activities within Canvas or other designated online platforms.
