AP Exam Registration

Registration for Advanced Placement exams begins Oct. 1. [Access tools and resources](#) for your AP class using the code from your AP teacher.

The first AP exam cost is \$99, and each additional exam is \$74. Student who qualify for free or reduced lunch are charged \$10 for each AP exam. [Payment](#) must be submitted in full by Friday, Nov. 6, or students may pay \$40 per exam by Nov. 6 with the remaining balance due by Jan. 29.

If you need financial assistance, pick up an AP Exam scholarship request form in Office B. Scholarship request forms are due back to Office B by Oct. 9 at 3 p.m. The scholarship committee will notify students of acceptance on Oct. 23.

Important Dates for AP Exam Registration:

Oct. 1 – Registration opens.

Oct. 9 – Scholarship forms are due.

Nov. 6 – Registration & fees are due.

Nov. 13 – Any exam ordered after this date will incur a \$40 late fee.

Jan. 29 – Balance is due for those on a payment plan.
