Virtual Passport to Success

Parents/guardians will need to complete a digital checklist of items, which include residency verification, Chromebook insurance, free and reduced lunch forms and parking permits in order to receive their child's schedule. The checklist will be available beginning Aug. 20.

To access the checklist, parents/guardians should log in to their child's Canvas account using the student's credentials. After completing the checklist, parents will be asked to provide a current email address, and school sites will directly email their child's class schedule to them. BAHS will begin sending schedules a week prior to school starting.

SAT Testing for Class of 2021

Due to recent budget cuts at the state level, the Oklahoma State Department of Education will not be funding a fall SAT for incoming seniors who missed taking the test during the state assessment window due to school closures last spring. The SAT test has been historically funded by the OSDE. Therefore, there will be no school day SAT test for incoming seniors this fall. Parents and students can visit the SAT/College Board website to register online for the SAT test. Available test dates are also listed on their website.
