High School Applicants: Reading and Math scores will be accepted from the Pre-Act, ACT, PSAT, or SAT. Students with no reading or math test scores are encouraged to test at the Tulsa Tech Assessment Center. The Assessment Center is located within the Client Service Center on the Lemley Memorial Campus at 3638 S. Memorial Dr. in Tulsa. Math and English grades may be submitted for the current school year.

Testing by appointment only, visit <http://tulsa.tech/testing> to schedule your appointment.

Adult Applicants: Must schedule a reading and math test at the Tulsa Tech Assessment Center unless you have ACT or SAT scores from the last five years or have earned an Associate's Degree or higher.

**Adult students are encouraged to apply for financial aid by completing the Free Application Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.gov. Tulsa Tech school code is: 012572.*

Priority Deadline: March 1, 2024

Selection will take place on an ongoing basis to fill seats as available.
