



Early College High School

- 9th and 10th grade courses are taught by BAPS faculty while dual credit classes (beginning after sophomore year) are taught by TCC Faculty in the Education Building at NSUBA
- Students will determine their pathway (DC2CD or Plus One) in the fall of their sophomore year

Transportation:

- Students will ride their regular bus to BAFA if they are in 9th grade or BAHS if they are 10-12th grade. When they unload, they'll need to get directly on the shuttle. There are signs marking the "ECHS Shuttle"
- Buses will take students back to BAFA or BAHS for 5th and/or 6th hour
- Student may drive and park at NSU-BA with a driver's license and BAHS Parking permit.

9th grade ECHS courses

- Pre-AP English 9
- Appropriate math course: Pre-AP Algebra I, Pre-AP Geometry, Pre-AP Algebra 2, Pre-AP PreCalculus
- Pre-AP Biology
- Pre-AP Oklahoma History/Pre-AP Government
- Orientation to College
- 6th period elective at BAFA

10th grade ECHS courses

- Pre-AP English 10
- Appropriate math course: Pre-AP Geometry, Pre-AP Algebra 2, Pre-AP Pre-Calculus
- Pre-AP Physical Science
- AP European History (the AP Exam is not required, but is advised)
- Elective at ECHS (Orientation to College, Environmental Science, Leadership) OR 5th period elective at BAHS
- 6th period elective at BAHS

Graduation Requirements

- World Language OR Computer Science - 2 years.
 - We recommend that students complete this by the end of their 10th grade year, but we know that there are some situations where this is not possible. Completing it by the end of the 11th grade year is acceptable.
 - BAFA has year long computer science courses and BAHS has primarily semester long
 - BAFA offers Spanish, French, Latin
 - BAHS offers Spanish, French, Latin (maybe German)
- You might notice on your schedule you did not get your top pick; we try to fill with World Language as much as possible
