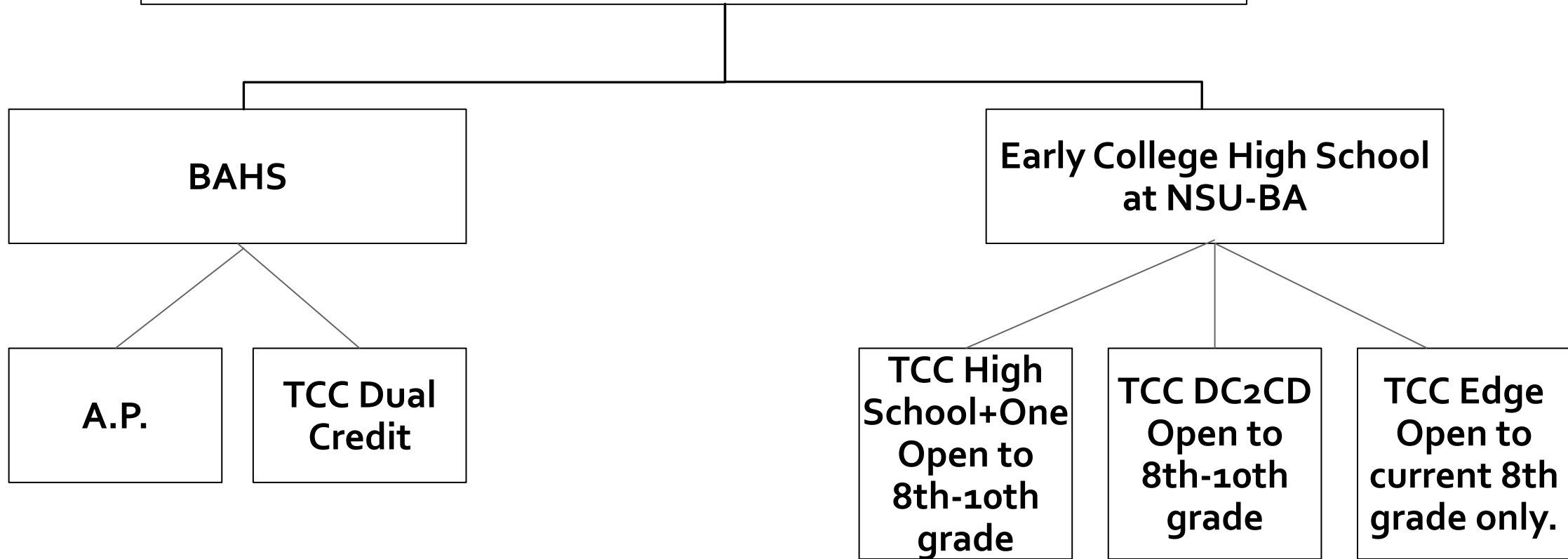

# High School Plus One

One year of college and high school diploma

## ECHS & Tulsa Community College

**9<sup>th</sup> Grade** Preparatory high school curriculum at ECHS or regular 9<sup>th</sup> grade at BAFA.

**10<sup>th</sup> Grade** Preparatory high school curriculum at ECHS or regular 10<sup>th</sup> grade at BAHS. Apply to TCC spring 10<sup>th</sup> grade.

**11<sup>th</sup> Grade** 3 ECHS/BAHS or BAVA courses and 2 TCC college courses each semester.

**12<sup>th</sup> Grade** 2 ECHS/BAHS or BAVA courses and 3 TCC college courses each semester.

# Dual Credit to College Degree

## Associate Degree Program and high school diploma

### ECHS & Tulsa Community College

**9<sup>th</sup> Grade**

Preparatory high school curriculum at ECHS or at BAFA.

**10<sup>th</sup> Grade**

Preparatory high school curriculum at ECHS or at BAHS.  
Apply to TCC spring 10<sup>th</sup> grade.  
Program begins summer after 10<sup>th</sup> grade for 6 semesters.

**11<sup>th</sup> Grade**

2 Summer courses required.  
1 BAHS or BAVA course and 4 TCC college courses each semester at NSU campus.  
Summer courses at TCC campus.

**12<sup>th</sup> Grade**

2 Summer courses required.  
1 BAHS or BAVA course and 4 TCC college courses each semester at NSU campus.

## College Program Approximate Cost

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One year of college - \$900.00

Two years of college – Oklahoma Promise - \$0; everyone else \$1800.

Normal Associate's degree - \$8,500 for a high school graduate at TCC; \$10-30,000 at an Oklahoma four year university.

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# More Logistics

- Students can still participate in end of the day other programs: Tulsa Tech, Athletics, Fine Arts, Band, etc.
- BA Transportation is provided
  - From home to BAFA for all grade levels
  - Shuttles from BAFA to ECHS - NSU-BA each morning
  - Shuttles to BAFA for 6th period and to BAHS for 5th and 6th periods.
- BA Lunch is provided by a food cart.
  - Students can also purchase from NSU's Cafe.

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# NEW Logistics

- **Students in the DC2CD Program will be required to attend support classes on Fridays at ECHS.**
  - Students can earn time at home with good grades.
  - Students will have space and room for study groups.
  - Students will have access to university resources.
  - Students will have access to high school teachers for support.
  - Students will be taught time management skills to plan their work and then work their plan.
  - Students will have more career planning services in preparation to transfer to a university.

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# ECHS Benefits

- Smaller School Population (Less than 200 students)
- Focused support for college entrance scores and college level work
- Peer groups/study groups
- Access to college resources in high school for higher college grades

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# Liberal Arts Associate's Degree

- Regular Pathway: TCC Math 1473 Quantitative Reasoning & TCC Biology for Non-STEM Majors
- Choice for those in STEM majors
  - TCC Math Pre-Calculus OR Algebra III in fall/Math Pre-Calc in spring for those who want more support.
  - TCC Biology for STEM Majors
- Additional Choices MAY be available during the last 18 hours of the degree to align with student's 4 year Bachelor's degree plan.
  - Cost of books would be parent's responsibility

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# ECHS application process:

1. Complete the ECHS DC2CD 10th grade online application **ASAP**.
2. Apply to TCC. You must have a 990 PSAT or 3.0 Unweighted GPA (Work with Ms. Lindsey Scott in break-out room.)
  - a. If you do not have either, see Mrs. Deliese Brewer to take Residual ACT to get a 19.
3. Apply to Oklahoma Promise if you may qualify. This will save you \$1800 if you qualify.
4. Once you are accepted to TCC and have a T#, then make sure that you have the 510 EBR&W score for all courses except math courses.
  - a. Work with your TCC advisor to take the Accuplacer if you do not.
5. Attend ECHS Enrollment for Summer (if DC2CD) and Fall courses on March 11th or 23rd.
