

PATHWAY CHOICES

HIGH SCHOOL PLUS ONE

- 31 hours = 1 yr. of college
- 4 semesters no summer [optional]
- Free tuition for 30 hours only pay fees
- State mandated fees only [\$29.45/hr]
- Free textbooks (some supplemental materials charge)
- Totally at NSU-BA
- 2 semesters to complete AS or AA degree post HS

DUAL CREDIT TO COLLEGE DEGREE

- 61 hours = AA degree
- 6 semesters; 2 summers not optional
- Liberal Arts with 2 options*
- Free tuition for 61 hours
- OKPromise scholars free
- Non-OKPromise scholars pay fees only.
- Option A Free textbooks (some supplemental materials charge)
- Option B 18/20 courses at NSU-BA
- Transfer to the university w/freshman status and junior hours post HS

OPTION A

- 18/20 courses at NSU-BA
- Full OER textbooks
- Transportation to NSU provided
- Academic advisement for transfer
- Low cost
- Stackable credential AA Liberal Arts

OPTION B

- 10+ courses at NSU-BA
- Textbook costs Sr. year
- Transportation cost Sr. year
- Academic advisement for tailored courses and transfer
- Potential higher cost
- Additional required meeting: student, parent, HS, and TCC
- Stackable credential AA Liberal Arts

Next Steps for Ineligible Students

- New transcript with updated GPA (unweighted)
- National ACT, SAT, pre-ACT, PSAT10, PSAT-NMSQ
- On-Campus / Residual ACT (once Nov. 1 Oct. 31)
- Accuplacer Reading/Writeplacer / Accuplacer Math
 - Referrals Advising
- Partially eligible: use the score they have (e.g., reading now, math later)
