

College Planning: 9th/10th Grade

- Create a four-year high school plan. Make sure you know which high school courses are required by colleges and that you're taking the right classes as early as the ninth grade.
- Explore AP courses.
- Meet with your guidance counselor. Make sure you are taking the appropriate classes for graduation.
- Start thinking about your life after school, including the types of jobs that might interest you.
- Participate in extracurricular activities.
- Study hard! Use good study habits and keep your grades up.
- Apply for OK Promise, if you qualify. Oklahoma's Promise offers qualified Oklahoma students an opportunity to earn a scholarship for college tuition.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be an Oklahoma resident.
 - Must enroll in the 8th, 9th or 10th grade.
 - The parents' federal adjusted gross income must not exceed \$55K per year.
- Check OK College Start for scholarship info, college and career searches.
 - Attend college and career fairs.
 - Tour college campuses. Sophomores have 1 excused day that can be used to visit colleges. Please bring proof of college visit to the College and Career Office.
